Long-term (12-month) PPIE Programme

with Indian and Pakistani communities in the UK to build trust, mutually upskill, and gather true-to life insights for clinical trial design

Community Listening Sessions

conducted in informal, community settings to gather inputs on clinical trial design, with strong feedback loops and open channels of communication

Training Community Leads to Facilitate Meetings

to work as connectors between the trial team and members of the community and gather insights that are true-to-life and actionable
